## T.E.A.C.H. can help!

You may be eligible to receive a scholarship if you:

- work in a direct service or supervisory role in a family support program operating in the state of Iowa that is receiving state or federal funds. Eligible programs include home visiting and group-based parent education programs.
- have worked in your current program for at least 6 months.
- are working towards approved college credit coursework at an Iowa college (or would like to be).
- have the support of your employer. Your program will receive a stipend to help defer the costs to their program after you complete your T.E.A.C.H. contract.
