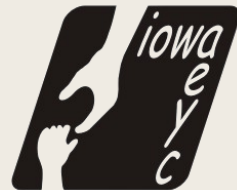

Funding for T.E.A.C.H. 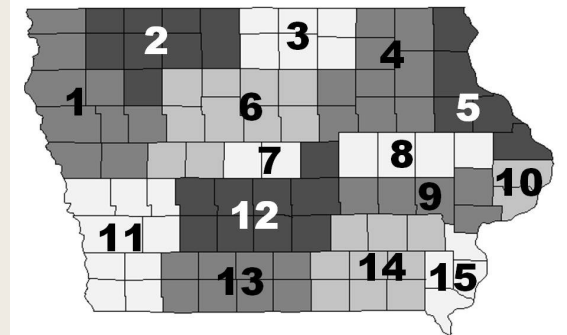


Iowa AEYC Annual Conference
